



SOCIAL CAREERS

The DUT Carrières Sociales, *option animation sociale et socioculturelle* national curriculum has been designed to train students who wish to engage with young people, adults and communities (including the elderly, people with disabilities and culturally diverse groups). The students are trained to assess the needs of individuals and communities in order to plan and carry out projects that promote social well-being and equal opportunity.

Teaching is provided by permanent teachers and academics (PHDs/ researchers). About 40 training associates join the team every year, most of whom are qualified Youth and Community work practitioners. Partners include local authorities and several social or youth and community organizations or networks.

CONTENTS OF OUR COURSE

- The programme offers a selection of academic and professional modules combined with fieldwork placements (2x2 weeks in the first year and 8 weeks in the second) requiring students to design and lead youth and community projects under the supervision of local youth and community organizations.
- Core modules include Sociology, Psychology, Economics, Law, Social and Cultural Policies, English language...
- Professional modules include : values and practice of Youth and Community Work (*Travail social et Animation socioculturelle*), project management, case studies...



ORGANIZATION OF OUR COURSE

- The year runs from the beginning of September to June.
 - Our students have around 35 hours a week of contact time , made up of lectures (principally all the 1st or 2nd year students, around 88 students), tutorial work (around 25 students), applied work and assignments / project work (around 14 students) and personal and professional project support in a small group (around 7 students).
- Once they have their diploma, our graduates can enter the world of work either immediately or after a further period of studies : International Degree (DUETI) Professional Bachelor's Degree (LP), Bachelor's Degree (L)

AFTER THE IUT

Differents possibilities exist for our students after graduating:

- Enter the professional world as “*animateur socioculturel*” in social or youth and community organizations, local authorities, old people homes...etc
- Continue with higher education: professional Bachelor degree, Bachelor Degree and Master in Science of education, D.U.E.T.I.(a degree for International Studies, which directly follows the DUT)

The Social Careers Department also offers a post-graduate “*licence professionnelle*” (a professional Bachelor's degree) in “*Coordination de projets d'animation d'animation de développement social et socioculturel*”.
